

EMERGENCY ACTION PLAN FOR BRAMDEAN & HINTON AMPNER

In all emergencies, including flooding, use the following procedure for calling out volunteers (eg telephone cascade). In the case of high water levels, implementation will be triggered when the water level in the ditch by The Old Rectory, Bramdean, rises to 60 cm/24" (measured by tape not depth of ditch).
