

## EMERGENCY ACTION PLAN FOR BRAMDEAN & HINTON AMPNER

In all emergencies, including flooding, use the following procedure for calling out volunteers (eg telephone cascade). In the case of high-water levels, implementation will be triggered when the level in the watercourse by The Old Rectory, Bramdean, rises to 60 cm/24” (measured by tape not depth).
